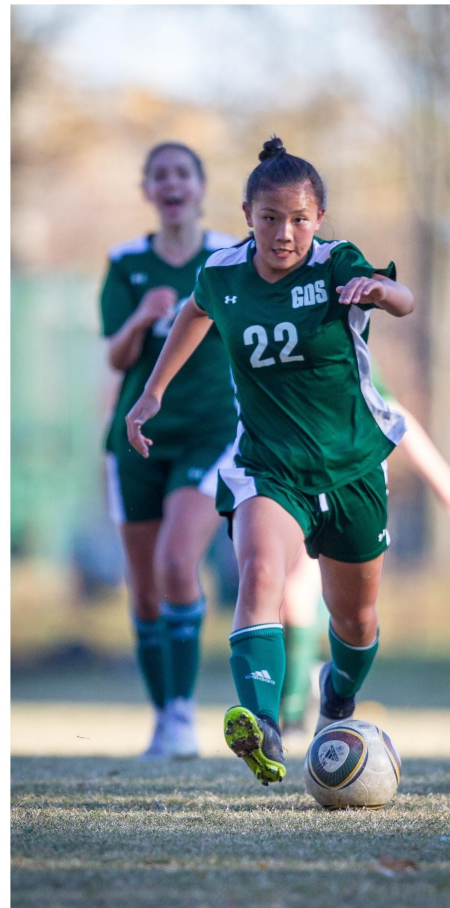
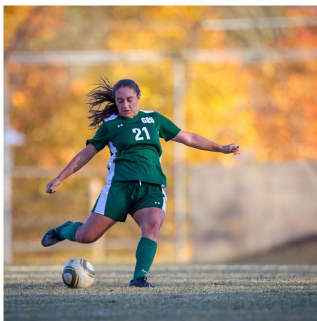
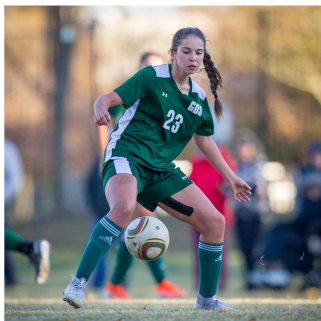
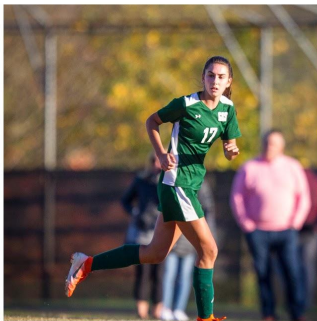
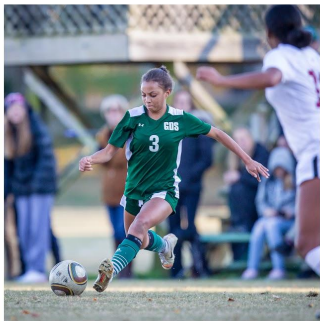
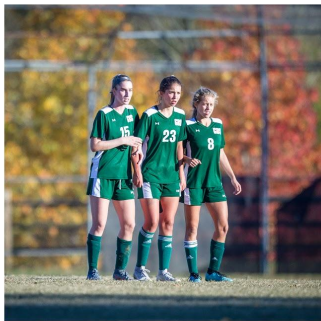
Top results of note:

**Women's Varsity Tennis** with wins this week over Holy Child and St Andrews!

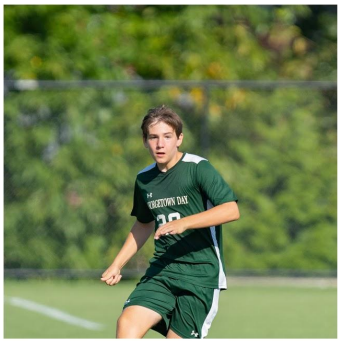
**Cross Country** DC Cross Country Invitational Top ten finishes:

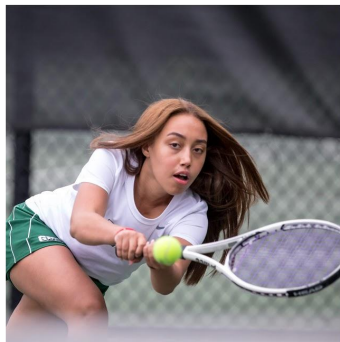
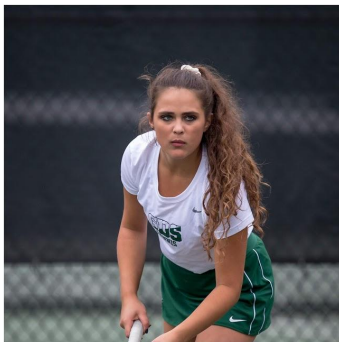

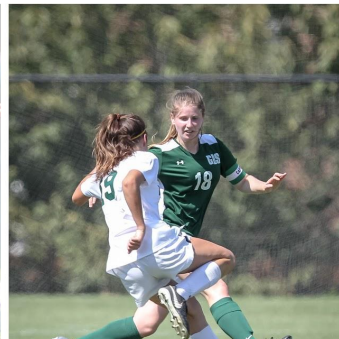
